This letter is to express continuing support from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' (USACE) Lower Missouri River Brunswick L-246 Study. This project seeks to provide protection and resiliency along the Missouri River near Brunswick, Missouri.

Missouri has been investing significant time and funding, along with the states of Kansas, Iowa, and Nebraska in Lower Missouri river resiliency since the flooding of 2019. Brunswick has been identified as a key area for focused work to increase protection and resiliency of the river, the ecosystem, and the citizens & agricultural resources near the town of Brunswick. The Department has been working with landowners, levee districts, industry, leaders from Brunswick, and other interested citizens to understand areas and causes of recurrent damages from flood events.

The USACE can bring valuable hydrology, hydraulic, and engineering expertise to develop solutions for this area. The Department fully supports continued investment of funding to address issues in this area to provide lasting benefit to all stakeholders.
