Dear Chairman Rogers and Ranking Member Smith:


I am requesting funding for the Aircraft Parking Apron project at Rosecrans Air National Guard Base in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Rosecrans Air National Guard Base, Missouri National Guard located at 705 Memorial Drive, St. Joseph, MO 64503.

The funding would be used for building a new aircraft parking apron. This project will support continued operations for the 139th Airlift Wing. The current parking apron and hangar complex is in an area subject to flooding. The wing developed a strategic plan to move military assets to an area of the base that alleviates this issue with future construction relying on a new parking apron.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 10 U.S.C. Chapter 169.
